apple, ant, egg, eskimo, igloo, ink, orange, office, umpire, up

2. Consonants: b c d f g h j k l m n p q r stvwxyz

Examples:

Bed, cat, dog, fan, goat, hat, jam, kite, lamp, mop, net, pig, queen, rabbit, snake, toy, vase, water, xylophone, yoyo, zebra.

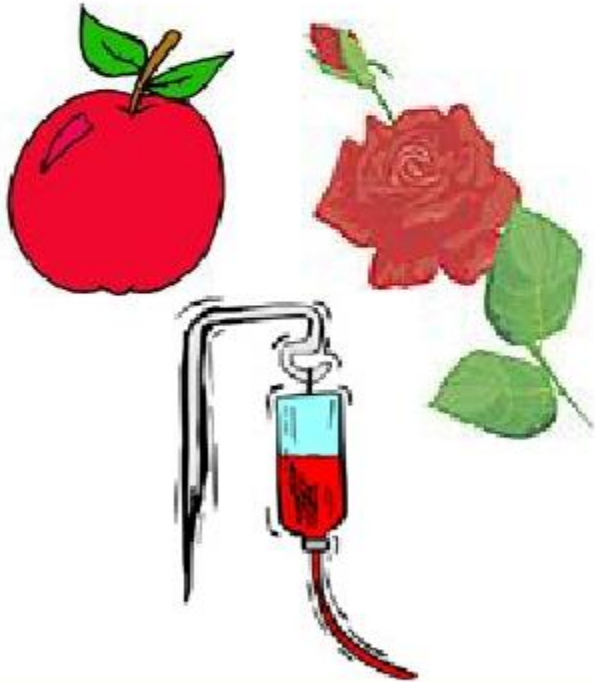

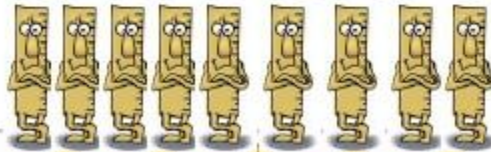

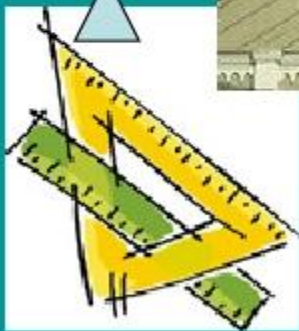
LESSON 18 : Triangle and Circle

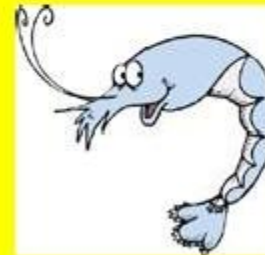
Oblong
