Step 2. Start describing from the background to the foreground, and from the left hand side to the right.

Step 3. Describe details on objects with its position in the picture. (Combine this step with the next in case there's not enough time.)

{Useful Expressions}

- in the fore/background
- in front of ~ / at the back of ~
- on the left/right hand side
- on the upper/lower left/right corner

Step 4. Imagine your answer based on the information in the picture.
